



Mid-Atlantic Diesel Collaborative
Steering Committee Charge to Sector Workgroups

(July 27, 2006)

The Mid-Atlantic Diesel Collaborative sector workgroups shall:

- Share information and expertise in order to build capacity in the Mid-Atlantic Region to reduce diesel emissions and protect public health.
- Develop and recommend grant applications and projects to implement the Mid-Atlantic Regional Diesel Campaign Strategy that maximize opportunities to
 - Reduce exposure to the toxic components of diesel emissions;
 - Support plans and programs to attain the national ambient air quality standards; and
 - Promote regional approaches.
- Consider the Project Evaluation Criteria adopted by the Committee when setting priorities, to ensure that projects in which the Collaborative participates are high quality, achieve needed emissions reductions, support regional efforts, and are timely and innovative.
- Work with the MARAMA Executive Director to present grant applications and project proposals for approval by the Steering Committee.
