



REGIONAL HAZE INVENTORY ASSESSMENT REPORT

MARCH 2001

DOCUMENT DESCRIPTION: The report “Assessment of Emissions Inventory Needs for Regional Haze Plans” identifies high priority activities needed to improve emissions inventories for regional haze planning. It recommends actions by state, local, and tribal agencies and by EPA to improve the emissions inventory, suggests regional collaboration, and notes that resource needs are substantial. The report encompasses a study area of states that are members of the Ozone Transport Commission (OTC), the Southeast States Air Resource Managers (SESARM), and West Virginia. The report was developed by Pacific Environmental Services, Inc (PES) for OTC and SESARM. The contract with PES was managed by MARAMA.

FOLLOW-UP ACTIONS RECOMMENDED:

- Review the CMU ammonia emissions inventory
- Review point source physical parameters (statewide, PM, SO₂, NO_x, NH₃, VOC)
- Identify point sources of condensable fine particulate matter
- Collect improved activity data for residential wood combustion and open burning sources
- Develop GIS tools to support model preprocessing
- Check emissions for industrial sources in categories listed as BART-eligible.
